### AGM MAY 2023:

A record 45 members attended the AGM, thank you.

Mark Agnew, General Manager of Shropshire North National Trust started the proceedings by giving an exhilarating talk about proposals for changes at our local National Trust Property at Attingham Park. He explained the issues and difficulties facing the Attingham Estate with regards to the expanding populations of both Telford and Shrewsbury. There are some exciting developments that they are hoping to put in place to expand the activities within this area so that the expected one million visitors can look forward to using this property for relaxation and exercise.

Lesley Dench, the out-going chair, started the AGM with her report, emphasising the necessity of having a full complement of Honorary Officers in order for the branch to continue to operate. Without these roles being filled, the branch will close, according to our constitution.

LD writes: *"The AGM which followed was disappointing as, despite repeated calls for someone to take up the post of Chair of the Church Stretton Branch u3a, no-one came forward during the meeting. All 6 current members of the Committee were voted in place plus a new member, Rachel Finch-Lees, whom we are pleased to welcome. The meeting closed with the proposal that an EGM be arranged as soon as possible in order to try to resolve the problem."*

The rest of the agenda was completed with the meeting closing with 7 committee members but no Chair.

LD writes: *"Fortunately Jane Davis came forward after the meeting and offered to fill the post for a year in order that the u3a could continue, and she has been co-opted onto the Committee to facilitate this. The committee is very grateful for this offer and so should all our members. This, however, only temporarily sorts the problem. I shall remain as Vice Chair for the year, in order to support Jane but really this post should be held by a potential future Chair, so the plea goes out yet again for someone to come forward."*
